

A – 4 (Our Identity)

- **Attract** with Love
 - Attract the unchurched with the love of Christ (John 13:34-35)
- **Arm** with the Truth
 - We are to Arm the unchurch with the Truth of God's Word (John 8:31-32, 17:17)
- **Affirm** with Faith
 - We are to Affirm them in their Faith in Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 1:24; Gal. 4:14)
- **Animate** with Hope
 - Once they are Affirmed in the Faith, they will become enthusiastically hopeful realizing the Word of God is true and their salvation is sure. (1 Pet 1:3, 3:15)

Key Statement: Expressing praise, thanks, and love for God, because of who He is and what He's done is something we should eagerly do while proclaiming His goodness.

- 1. God is worthy of our thanks (v 1)
- 2. God is good (*v* 1)
- 3. God loves us (*v 1*)
- 4. God has saved many of us (v 2)
- 5. God expects us to speak out for Him (v 2)
- 6. God has gathered us throughout the world (v 3)
