- **Attract** with Love
Attract the unchurched with the love of Christ (John 13:34-35)
- **Arm** with the Truth
We are to Arm the unchurch with the Truth of God’s Word (John 8:31-32, 17:17)

Key Statement: Expressing praise, thanks, and love for God, because of who He is and what He’s done is something we should eagerly do while proclaiming His goodness.

1. I praise God for the deliverance from hunger and thirst in the wilderness.
2. I praise God for the deliverance from the shadow of death and prison.
3. I praise God for the deliverance from the sickness and illnesses due to my iniquities.
4. I praise God for the deliverance from the perils of the waves of the sea.
5. Ponder on the loving kindness of the Lord.

Personal Prayer: Lord, You have watched over me and delivered me from so much. When I was in the wilderness and didn’t know which way to go, you delivered me. When I was imprisoned by sin, You delivered me from the shadow of death. When I was sick in my body You delivered me from the gates of death. And when I was being tossed to and fro by the waves of life, You delivered me from the perils of the sea. Every time I found myself in trouble due to the pressures of the world, I cried out to You and You brought me through. The divine deliverance is just an expression of Your love for me. But the real display of your love is that You gave Your only begotten Son to die on the cross for my sins and for this I cannot thank You enough. You are so good to me; You have blessed me immensely and I’m so grateful! I realize I don’t deserve all that You do for me, which forces me to praise You and worship You to the best of my ability. You have redeemed me and I must proclaim Your goodness to everyone You send my way. Please Lord, give me the boldness to speak out for You. Help me to truly begin living my life in a way that glorifies You. Help me emulate what it means to live out A-4 in my life. I live to love and to serve You in all that I do.
