A – 4 (Our Identity)

- **Attract** with Love
Attract the unchurched with the love of Christ (John 13:34-35)
- **Arm** with the Truth
We are to Arm the unchurch with the Truth of God's Word (John 8:31-32, 17:17)
- **Affirm** with Faith
We are to Affirm them in their Faith in Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 1:24; Gal. 4:14)
- **Animate** with Hope
Once they are Affirmed in the Faith, they will become enthusiastically hopeful realizing the Word of God is true and their salvation is sure. (1 Pet 1:3, 3:15)

John 15:1-11

Key Statement: We must abide in the vine to produce good fruit, because away from the vine, we can do nothing.

1. The unprofitable branches are discarded.
2. A branch cannot bear fruit by itself.
3. Are you remaining attached to Christ?
4. Are you unattached and on the verge of being discarded?
5. Does the fruit you bear prove you are a disciple?
6. Does your life produce evidence of abiding in His love?
